**2013 -- *The Year for Schools to Accelerate Development of a Unified & Comprehensive System to Address Barriers to Learning and Teaching***

***This is the year to end the myth that teachers can do it all alone.***

School improvement requires ensuring that teachers have collaborative supports for addressing barriers to learning and teaching and re-engaging disconnected students.

Such supports need to be developed for each school in the form of a *unified* and comprehensive system of *in-classroom and school-wide* learning supports.

Developing such a system at a school requires moving learning supports out of the margins of school improvement policy and practice during 2013.

***Fortunately, a good foundation for accelerating the work has been built.***

### **What to do right away.**
